## Comments on Recommendations Contained in Paragraph 9 of

Recommendation a: "USIB reaffirm the high priority for intelligence activity against Communist China, endorse the need for developing a strong intelligence data base and an intelligence competence against China commensurate with that against other highest priority targets."

Comment: It is believed that any statement by USIE concerning the priority to be accorded a subject or an area should be made in the context of the current, approved Priority National Intelligence Objectives (DCID 1/3). To do otherwise would tend to undermine the bases of the existing priority system and introduce uncertainty and doubt as to USIB's true intentions. Accordingly, it is suggested that this recommendation be reworded as follows: "USIB call to the attention of member agencies the substantive intelligence problems relating to Communist China set forth in the current DCID 1/3, Priority National Intelligence Objectives, and endorse the need for developing a strong data base and an intelligence competence against Communist China in accordance therewith."
