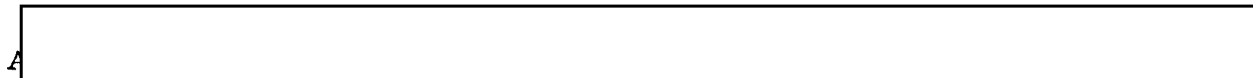

I asked Braswell for his opinion as to when he thought the Senate would get into a discussion of Southeast Asian programs. He said this was very uncertain but it could come up as early as next week.

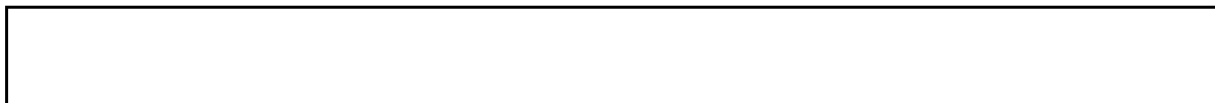
