This is in response to your letter of September 28, 1971, requesting a report on H. R. 10869, a bill "To amend the Comprehensive Drug Abuse Prevention and Control Act of 1970 to provide for an annual report by the Secretary of State to Congress on the international production and consumption of, and trade in, narcotic drugs."

We have no objection to the proposed legislation.
