

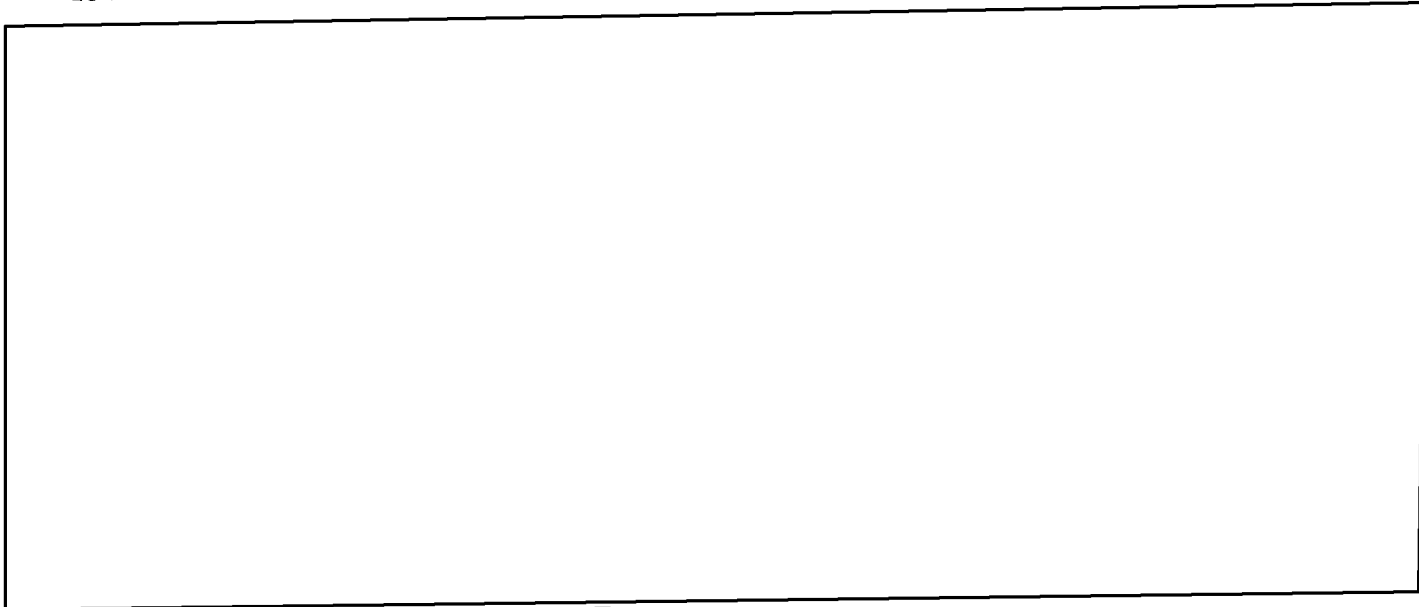

[redacted] Received a call from Frank Slatinshek, Assistant Chief Counsel, House Armed Services Committee, who told me he had just talked to Chairman Lucien Nedzi, Intelligence Subcommittee, who is somewhat concerned about the coup in Ghana. Nedzi would like to know to what extent the intelligence community was aware of the coup planning and noted that "we let Mrs. Nixon go down there." I thanked Slatinshek for the call and told him we would brief him on the Ghana coup tomorrow.
