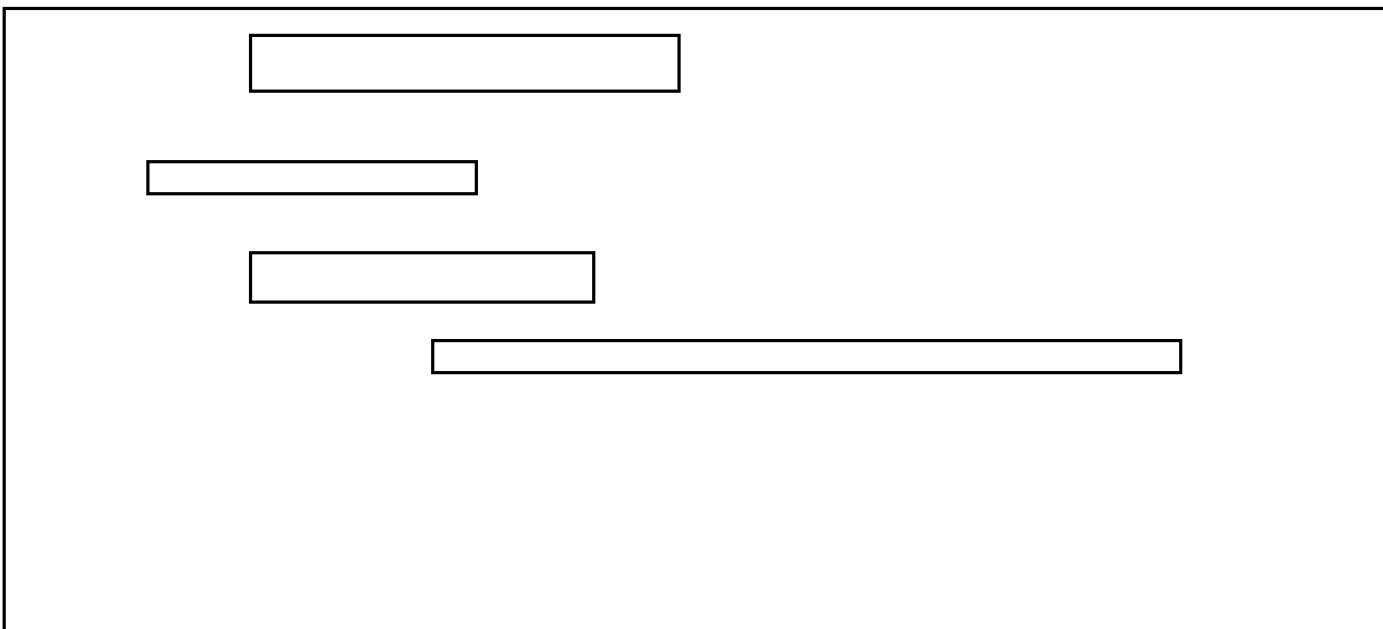

[redacted] Accompanied [redacted] OSI, and [redacted] OSI, to the Joint Committee on Atomic Energy office for a briefing on the construction of the naval vessel at Nikolayev and a discussion about the Soviet icebreaker, "Lenin."
