25X1 [redacted] Met with Mr. John R. Blandford, Chief Counsel,
House Armed Services Committee, who told me that there had been no
further developments within the Committee regarding the new Subcommittee
on Intelligence. Mr. Blandford would suggest, however, that it might be
well if the Agency can deal with the new Subcommittee Chairman and the
members of the new Subcommittee as a unit rather than dealing with him as an
individual in providing briefings and so forth. Otherwise we could run the
risk of upsetting the existing arrangements for dealing only with Messrs. Hebert
and Arends on matters of substance. I thanked Mr. Blandford for the advice.
