The CIA Subcommittees of Senate Armed Services and Appropriations met on 14 July 1966 without any Agency witnesses to discuss the floor action scheduled for later in the day on the resolution to establish a Committee on Intelligence Operations with members of Senate Foreign Relations participating. The Subcommittees had met in both April and May without Agency witnesses to consider moves within Senate Foreign Relations regarding legislative oversight of the Agency.
