Raborn Says He Quit C.I.A.
For the 'Lure of Industry'

NORFOLK, Va., June 24 (AP)

The "Lure of Industry" proved too much for Vice Adm. William F. Raborn Jr., former director of Central Intelligence, said today.

Admiral Raborn, who was appointed CIA chief 14 months ago, resigned last Saturday.

"The lure of industry was such that I couldn't pass it up,"

he said. "I went there with the thought I could go when I wanted to."

But Admiral Raborn, who addressed a graduating class at the Armed Forces Staff College, did not disclose his plans.
