The CIA's deputy director, Richard M. Helms, was named director of the intelligence agency, succeeding William F. Raborn, who resigned. President Johnson also appointed as chairman of the Federal Communications Commission Rosel H. Hyde, currently acting chairman, and as an FCC member, Nicholas Johnson, now Federal maritime administrator. Samuel Nabrit, president of Texas Southern University, was named the first Negro member of the Atomic Energy Commission.
