Groton School Prize Day Held

GROTON, June 16 — A graduating class of 36 boys received diplomas at the annual prize day exercises at Groton School yesterday. The principal address was given by Richard M. Bissell of the class of 1928, who is affiliated with the Central Intelligence Agency.

Prizes were presented by Rev. John Crocker, headmaster, and diplomas were awarded by Samuel S. Duryée of New York, president of the board of trustees. Some of the outstanding prize winners were as follows:

Debating prize, given in memory of President Franklin D. Roosevelt, 1900, by W. Averell Harriman, 1909, won by James P. McBaine; Endicott Peabody Memorial Prize, William A. Nitze 2d; Charles L. Appleton prize awarded to a member of the sixth from who has greatly served the school, John Parkinson Keyes 2d; Frederick Greeley Crocker Memorial Award to a member of the junior class at college whose record at college has reflected credit upon himself and the school, John Adams Bross, Jr.
