(POLICE)

A HIGH OFFICIAL OF THE CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE AGENCY (CIA) TOLD 1,500 AMERICAN AND FOREIGN POLICY CHIEFS THAT FREE WORLD POLICE ARE ONE OF THE PRIMARY TARGETS FOR COMMUNIST SUBVERSION.

LYMAN B. KIRKPATRICK JR., CIA INSPECTOR GENERAL, SAID IN AN ADDRESS TO THE 67TH ANNUAL CONFERENCE OF THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF CHIEFS OF POLICE THAT AS LONG AS THERE ARE COMMUNISTS THEIR GOAL WILL BE "CONTROL OF THE WORLD."

PRESIDENT EISENHOWER ALSO SCHEDULED A SPEECH TODAY TO THE ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS.

KIRKPATRICK TOLD THE OFFICIALS THAT THE COMMUNIST "CAPABILITY FOR CONSPIRATORIAL WORK LARGELY ACCOUNTS FOR THE SURVIVAL OF THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNIST MOVEMENT."

BUT HE SAID THAT AN EFFICIENT POLICE FORCE PREPARED TO COMBAT BOTH OVERO COMMUNIST AGITATION AND SUBVERSION CAN PARALYZE THE COMMUNIST PARTY IN ANY COUNTRY.

HE DESCRIBED IN DETAIL THE TECHNIQUES BY WHICH COMMUNISTS HAVE WORKED TO UNDERMINE POLICE EFFICIENCY IN FOREIGN COUNTRIES. ONE TECHNIQUE, HE SAID, IS TO STAGE RIOTS IN AN ATTEMPT TO PORTRAY THE POLICE AS INCOMPETANT AND REPRESSIVE.

THE CIA OFFICIAL WARNED THAT THE COMMUNISTS ARE "FANATICAL, DISCIPLINED AND SKILLED IN UNDERGROUND METHODS" AND HAVE DEVELOPED AN EFFECTIVE SYSTEM TO PROTECT THEMSELVES AGAINST THE POLICE, INTELLIGENCE AGENCIES AND A HOSTILE PUBLIC.
