Navy Nominates 31 For Flag Rank; Son Of Admiral on List

An admiral's son and an Alexandria man were among 31 captains nominated yesterday for promotion to Rear Admiral by the Department of the Navy.

James L. Holloway III, son of retired Adm. James L. Holloway Jr., former superintendent of the Naval Academy, is 44 and holds the Navy Commendation Medal and Bronze Star Medal, each with a combat "V" attached.

Capt. Holloway also holds the Distinguished Flying Cross, the Air Medal with two Gold Stars, and a Gold Star in lieu of a second Navy Commendation Medal.

Capt. Julian T. Burke Jr., of Alexandria, was among the nominees. He holds the Bronze and Silver Stars, and was a submarine officer in World War II.

Halloway and Burke are graduates of the U.S. Naval Academy.
