## Robert Clapp, Executive At CIA, Dies

Robert Allan Clapp, a Central Intelligence Agency executive, died Friday at Sibley Memorial Hospital.

Associated with CIA since 1952.

Mr. Clapp's work was concerned with personnel matters. He also served as the Agency's representative on the President's Committee for the Employment of the Physically Handicapped.



A native of New Haven, Conn., Mr. Clapp received degrees from Oberlin College and Harvard University. He also attended Columbia Teachers College in New York. He served as headmaster of the Blake School in Hopkins, Minn., and acting headmaster of Browne and Nichols in Cambridge, Mass. Mr. Clapp was also director of Off Campus Activities at Hofstra College in Hempstead, N. Y., and served in the Navy as a first lieutenant.

He belonged to several educational organizations and resided at 5605 Parkston rd. in Springfield, Md.

Survivors include his wife, Mary Mignot Clapp; two children, Roger and Elizabeth, and his mother, Mrs. Raymond G. Clapp of Moylan, Pa.
