U.S. Locates Former Agent After 9 Days

FRANKFURT Reliable sources sidd today a former United states intelligence employe who had been reported missing has turned up at his home in Anaheim, Calif.

Martin B. Hebeling 35, of San Francisco recertly respect job in Berlin Army headquarters said he was sought after he had disappeared nine days ago.

Mr. Hebeling was a civilian enploye with a class fication equivalent to Army captain.

The Army said Mr. Hebeling, after resigning, was last seen January 19 at Helmstedt, the first West German town traveers from West Berlin reach after crossing 110 miles of Communist East Germany.

He was to return to the United States, the Army said, and was to have driven his car to Bremerhaven for shipment home. The car never was delivered to the total, leading to reports he was intssing. An Army spokesman said Mr. Hebeling as a private citizen after quitting his job was not obligated to report any-
