TASS ON CUBAN ESPIONAGE

MOSCOW TASS INTERNATIONAL SERVICE IN ENGLISH 1725Z 11 AUG 65 L

(TEXT) HAVANA, 11 AUGUST--THREE AGENTS OF THE U.S. CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE AGENCY WERE SENTENCED TO DEATH BY THE HAVANA REVOLUTIONARY TRIBUNAL FOR ATTEMPTED ACTS OF SABOTAGE AGAINST SHIPS OF THE CUBAN MERCHANT MARINE.

THE THREE MEN--ROBERTO FERNANDEZ COBO, PAUL PEREIRA CASTANEDA AND ROGER SARRIN DEPERA HINOJOSA--BELONGED TO AN ESPIONAGE AND SABOTAGE RING ORGANIZED BY THE CIA. THEY WERE RECRUITED IN EUROPEAN PORTS BY A CIA OFFICER CALLED "PETER."

THE TRAITORS WERE TAUGHT ESPIONAGE AND SABOTAGE WORK AND SUPPLIED WITH THE NECESSARY EQUIPMENT: A SPECIAL DEVICE FOR ARSON AND EXPLOSIONS IN SHIPS AND PORT WAREHOUSES, A RADIO STATION, CIPHERS, AND MONEY, ALL OF WHICH WERE SEIZED DURING THE ARREST.

HINOJOSA SAID HE HAD BEEN INSTRUCTED TO PLACE INCENDIARY BOMBS ON THE SHIP MANUEL ASCUNCE, SET FIRE TO A WAREHOUSE, AND SABOTAGE A DRY DOCK UNDER CONSTRUCTION IN THE PORT OF HAVANA. THE TWO OTHER MEN OPERATED ON A GONZALES LINES SHIP.

THE SENTENCE HAS BEEN CARRIED OUT.
