Emmett J. McCarthy, 52;
Circled World 17 Times

Emmett J. McCarthy, 52, of the Central Intelligence Agency, was buried with full military honors at Arlington National Cemetery yesterday. He died after a heart attack suffered in his Washington home Friday.

Mr. McCarthy, who lived at 1201 Cathedral ave. n.w., traveled around the world 17 times in the course of his Government service.

Mr. McCarthy was educated in the parochial schools of Butte Mont., where he was born. He attended Carroll College at Helena, Mont., and

received his bachelor's degree from George Washington University in 1956.

During World War II Mr. McCarthy served in the Office of Strategic Services and in "McCarthy's Marauders."

He was stationed in Southeast Asia, and received a combat infantryman's badge, Bronze Star and a Presidential Unit Citation for his services.
