 CAIRO, DECEMBER 29 (AP) - THE FEDERAL PUBLIC STATE PROSECUTOR
 IN A SECRET SESSION OF THE SUPREME MILITARY TRIBUNAL WEDNESDAY,
 REPORTEDLY DEMANDED THE DEATH PENALTY FOR FORMER EDITOR MUSTAFA
 AMIN, WHO IS CHARGED WITH BETRAYING MILITARY INFORMATION TO A
 U.S. INTELLIGENCE AGENT.
 RELIABLE SOURCES SAID THE PROSECUTOR ENDED HIS PLEA AND THE
 COURT WILL RESUME IN SECRET SESSION SATURDAY TO LISTEN TO THE
 DEFENSE PLEA.
 THE TRIAL BEGAN TUESDAY WHEN AMIN PLEADED INNOCENT TO CHARGES OF
 PASSING INFORMATION HARMFUL TO EGYPT TO U.S. CONSUL
 EMBASSY POLITICAL AFFAIRS OFFICER BRUCE TAYLOR ODELL.
