Don L. Purcell, 34, research analyst for Stanford Research Institute, died Thursday of cancer at his home, 11400 Washington Plaza, Reston, Va.

Mr. Purcell had been with Stanford one year. From 1967 to 1966 he worked for the Central Intelligence Agency.

A native of Los Angeles, he moved to the Washington area in 1963. Formerly he was an engineer at the California Institute of Technology's Jet Propulsion Laboratory.

Mr. Purcell was a staff sergeant in the Air Force from 1952 to 1959. He graduated from Pasadena (Calif.) City College in 1959 and from the University of California at Berkeley in 1963.

Survivors include his wife, Dorothy, his mother, Anna Zentner Purcell of Glendale, Calif.; his father, Ralph L. Purcell of Monrovia, Calif., and a brother, William of Chicago.
