(TEXT) MOSCOW--1. MELNIKOV, A SPECIAL CORRESPONDENT OF THE NOVOSTI PRESS SERVICE, DESCRIBES HIS MEETINGS IN HELSINKI WITH AMERICAN INTELLIGENCE AGENTS MAX RALLIS AND JACK STEWART, WHO HAD BEEN INSTRUCTED BY THEIR BOSSES TO STAGE ANTIFACIST PROVOCATIONS DURING THE RECENT EIGHTH WORLD FESTIVAL OF YOUTH AND STUDENTS. THE AUTHOR ALSO DESCRIBES HOW AND WHY THE SHAMEFUL MISSION OF RALLIS AND STEWART FAILED AND THAT THEY REMAINED IN ISOLATION IN THE FESTIVAL CAPITAL.

V. SILANTYEV CONTRIBUTES AN ITEM ON THE ARRIVAL IN BRITAIN OF AMERICAN U-2 RECONNAISSANCE PLANES.
