~~Harrison Gardener Reynolds~~, 61, a former resident of Washington and Central Intelligence Agency employe, died yesterday at his home in Beverly Farms, Mass.

Mr. Reynolds had lived in Washington for four years and earned the Intelligence Medal of Merit for his work with the CIA.

A veteran of three wars, he served on the Mexican border in 1917, in France during World War I, and as provost marshal of the Air Corps during World War II.

He is survived by his wife, Jean Fletcher Reynolds; a daughter, Mrs. Kennedy Middendorf, of Syosset, N. Y.; a son, Philip M. of Wenham, Mass.; six grandchildren, a sister and a brother.

Funeral services will be held at 2:30 p. m. Tuesday at St. John's Church in Beverly Farms. The family asks that instead of sending flowers, friends contribute to the American Cancer Society.
