Counsel for the plaintiff respectfully requests a hearing in the above-styled case concerning the following matters:

- 1. Hearing on Motion to Strike Order Allowing Amendment of Answer.
- 2. Hearing on Objections to Interrogatories.
- 3. Hearing on Motion for Summary Judgment.
- 4. Hearing on in camera Filings of May 31, 1966.

Several days ago, I talked to Mr. Connolly about suggesting a date for the hearing to Your Honor that would be convenient to all counsel and which could be accommodated in the schedule of the Court. However, Mr. Connolly advised me that in the Transcript of Proceedings of May 13, 1966, Your Honor had outlined a timetable for the filing of briefs and also for the request by either side for an oral argument on the issues. He stated that he had not requested an oral argument, but that if I do so, that the same be set for the third or fourth week in September.
