Slander Suit Involving CIA Is Continued

BALTIMORE, May 13—The
CIA slander case was continued after a hearing in Federal
Court today for further filing
of briefs by both sides and
possible final arguments late
in August on a defense motion for dismissal.

Canadian Eerik Heine is suing Juri Raus of Washington, an acknowledged operative of the Central Intelligence Agency, for calling him a Soviet secret police agent sent to infiltrate Estonian emigre circles.

Raus's defense is that he was acting as a CIA agent under specific instructions to calling Heine a Soviet spy.
