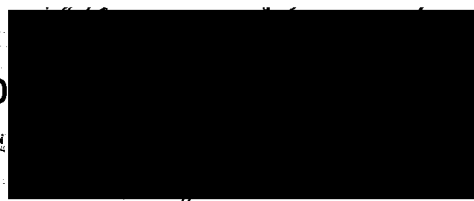

SUBJECT: Heine v. Raus Case

I spoke with Barrett Prettyman this afternoon, who said that Orr Kelly, of the Evening Star, will be present at the hearing in the morning in Baltimore in the Heine v. Raus case. He has read all of the proceedings including the depositions and spent a week in Canada interviewing Heine. He heard about the case through a representative of the Star who has met with Raskauskas socially. Prettyman told him as little as was necessary but pointed out that Raus was unable fully to defend his position in view of the national security issue. Kelly had apparently taken the attitude from reading the pleadings that Heine had been slandered by Raus. Prettyman hoped that his discussions with him dissuaded him from this view. I called [redacted] about this, who had already talked to Prettyman about it. [redacted] said he believed he was fully prepared to attend the hearing in the morning after having been

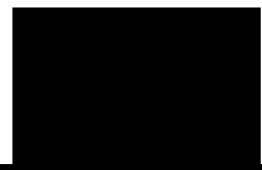
