M. D. Shaw Of CIA Dies At 55

Marion Dale Shaw, 55, of Washington, D.C., a former Peorian, died at 2:30 a.m. Saturday at his home in Washington.

He had been associated with the Central Intelligence Agency of the U.S. Government for the last 11 years. Born in Peoria Oct. 3, 1907, he was a son of Joseph Perry and Dollie Cleveland Shaw, and married Mary G. Geason Aug. 4, 1933. A graduate of Peoria High School with the class of 1925, he was well known in local golfing circles and had won many awards in competition here.

Surviving are his wife, his mother, Mrs. Dollie Watson of Peoria; one son, Spencer Shaw, at home; three daughters, Miss Sandra Shaw of London, England, and Miss Susan Shaw and Miss Marjorie Shaw, both at home; one sister, Mrs. Dewey W. (Gardner) Smith of East Peoria, and one stepson, Robert E. Watson of Peoria.

Funeral services will be held Sunday morning at the Hanlon Funeral Home in Washington, D.C., with burial here.
