1. On 12 October 1966, [redacted] Chief, Motor Pool Branch of this Agency reported the following:

[redacted] Office of General Counsel has informed [redacted] that Mr. Sam Langerman of the D.C. Transit Company called [redacted] to advise that Langerman intends to subpoena the Chief of the Motor Pool Branch to appear at a court hearing scheduled for 20 October 1966. Langerman did not mention [redacted] by name.

2. The subject matter, reportedly, concerns the six cents per mile rate which the Department of Interior is charging the D.C. Transit Company for the operation of buses on the George Washington Memorial Parkway.

The undersigned apprised [redacted] Assistant General Counsel, Office of Logistics, of this matter and was informed by [redacted] that he has been dealing with the Department of Justice relative to this subject for the past three years. [redacted] provided a copy of his latest memorandum dated October 1966 (see attached). It is [redacted] opinion that if an Agency representative is to be subpoenaed, it should be [redacted] 25X1A supervisor, [redacted] Chief, LSD/OL, who in addition to be the appropriate individual is a trained lawyer who could respond more effectively.
