MEANWHILE, THE GOVERNMENT NEWSPAPER IZVESTIA TONIGHT OPENED SOVIET PRESS ATTACKS ON THE WINTERS' CASE.

UNDER A HEADLINE "ALL ROADS LEAD TO DULLES," THE NEWSPAPER QUOTED WINTERS' MOTHER AS SAYING HER SON ONCE WORKED FOR THE CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE DEPARTMENT AND ADDED THAT WINTERS RETURNED TO MOSCOW "DREAMING ABOUT CHANCES TO CARRY OUT ESPIONAGE WITHOUT ANY OBSTACLES.

"BUT THIS DID NOT HAPPEN AND IT NEVER WILL HAPPEN TO HIS COLLEAGUES OF THE AMERICAN DIPLOMATIC DEPARTMENT OR FROM ALLEN DULLES' DEPARTMENT," IZVESTIA SAID. "JUDGING FROM DEVELOPMENTS, THESE DEPARTMENTS ARE TWINS."
