Burial Services Held in Arlington For Admiral Wylie

Burial services for Rear Admiral William N. Wylie, retired, were held this morning in Arlington Cemetery with full military honors. He died Tuesday in Brevard, N. C.

Admiral Wylie, 52, commanded the submarine USS Scorpion in 1943-4 and saw action in most of the major Pacific naval operations of that period.

His postwar assignments included duty with the Allied Control Commission for Hungary, the post of United States military attaché in Finland, two years of special duty with the Central Intelligence Agency and assignments with the United States Military Advisory Groups in Yugoslavia and Norway.

He leaves his wife, Eileen, and daughter Anne, both of Brevard.
