Senate Republican Leader Everett M. Dirksen said efforts to compromise a Senate fight over Central Intelligence Agency supervision apparently have collapsed and the issue will probably have to be settled on the floor.

Dirksen himself rejected one plan — for a new and independent nine-man Foreign Relations subcommittee to keep tabs on the CIA in the foreign policy field, with President Johnson as arbiter if the CIA refused to divulge requested information. Mr. Johnson reportedly withheld his blessing.
