FOLLIS DIED IN DROWNING

Coroner Finds No Foul Play
In Professor's Death

Amsterdam, Jan. 5 (AP)—A Dutch coroner today found that a noted United States Government pathologist, whose body was recovered yesterday from one of Amsterdam's canals, had died from drowning and that there was no evidence of foul play.

A police spokesman said that the investigation by Dr. Jan Zeldénrust showed that Professor Richard Follis, 56, disappeared here December 4 during a stop-over on the way to a nutrition conference in Tehran, Iran. Dr. Follis was a nutrition expert for the Veterans Administration.

A decision will be made tomorrow about shipping the body back to the United States. He is a native of Baltimore and his family lives in Washington.

Services Set

Memorial services for Dr. Follis will be held at 4 P.M. Sunday at the Westmoreland Congregational Church in Chevy Chase, Md. Graveside services, at a date to be announced later, will be held afterwards in Greenmount Cemetery.
