**Fulbright Move  
On CIA Delayed**

A Senate showdown over supervision of the Central Intelligence Agency has been delayed until after July 4.

Senate Democratic Leader Mike Mansfield said plans are to have Sen. J. William Fulbright, D-Ark., introduce after the holiday recess his resolution to place three members of his Foreign Relations Committee on the special committee that watches over CIA activities.

Sen. Richard B. Russell, D-Ga., chairman of the CIA committee, opposes the move.
