Sen. J. William Fulbright (D-Ark.) continues his efforts to cut three members of his Senate Foreign Relations Committee in on the small, close-mouthed Senate subcommittee that keeps an eye on the Central Intelligence Agency.

CIA's director—Adm. W. F. Raborn, Ret.—says politely but firmly that he is giving Fulbright most of the back of his hand, and in effect challenges the Arkansas segregationist to bring on a Senate floor fight.

It is hard to imagine a majority of Senators voting to loose a trio of Fulbright-type snoopers on our big spy agency. Let's have the matter settled for years to come by a Senate showdown and a decisive vote.
