## Dean's Fund Linked With CIA Finance

Hunt Denies Agency  
Influenced His Group

A foundation accused of transmitting Central Intelligence Agency money has contributed to the Fund for International Social and Economic Education, the president of which is Richard M. Hunt, assistant dean of the Graduate School of Arts and Sciences.

Hunt's organization received \$25,000 in 1965 from the J. Frederick Brown Foundation of Boston. Officers of the National Student Association have recently identified the Brown Foundation as one of their sources of CIA funds.

But Hunt said last night that he was unaware of the foundation's link to the CIA at the time the contribution was made.
