B-26 Smuggling Trial

BUFFALO—Jurors have been selected for a trial charging the illegal export of B-26 bombers, a case in which the defense claims it was acting under operating instructions from the Central Intelligence Agency.

John R. Hawke, one of the defendants, says the CIA backed the operation, in which he and several others flew bombers from various points in the United States to Portugal. The Government has denied the contention.
