ADD COMMITTEE JURISDICTION, WASHINGTON (UPI-102)
CIA OFFICIALS BRIEFED THE FOREIGN RELATIONS COMMITTEE'S LATIN
AMERICAN SUBCOMMITTEE IN AN AFTERNOON SESSION DEVOTED MOSTLY TO
DEVELOPMENTS IN CUBA. SEN. ROBERT B. NICKENLOOPER, R-IA., SAID
THE SUBCOMMITTEE WAS TOLD THAT THE CUBAN ECONOMY IS GRADUALLY DRYING
UP.

AS TO THE QUESTIONING, NICKENLOOPER SAID SUBCOMMITTEE QUESTIONS
WERE ANSWERED CANDIDLY WITH NO INFORMATION WITHHELD. ONE OF THE
PROPOSALS FOR COMPROMISING THE CIA DISPUTE WOULD CREATE A NEW FOREIGN
RELATIONS SUBCOMMITTEE ON CIA, BUT THERE HAVE BEEN COMPLAINTS THAT
CIA IN THE PAST HAS REFUSED TO SUPPLY SOME DATA EXCEPT TO THE REGULAR
WATCHDOG SUBCOMMITTEE.
