Otepka Wins 5th Delay

Washington, May 10 (UPI)—

The State Department said today that Otto Otepka has been granted a fifth postponement of the hearing on his appeal against his dismissal as chief of evaluation of the department's security office. Otepka was fired last year by Secretary of State Rusk for allegedly providing confidential information to a Senate Security subcommittee. He remains in his \$19,310-a-year post until the case is decided. Otepka asked for this postponement because the subcommittee advised him it would be August before the full transcript of testimony involving him would be made available.
