Red China Allows American to Visit Imprisoned Son

The American Red Cross announced today the Red Chinese have given permission for Mrs. Ruth Redmond, 64, Yonkers, N. Y., to make another visit to her son, held there as a prisoner.

She will be permitted to enter Red China sometime in mid-October to see her son, 43-year-old Hugh F. Redmond, jr., who is serving a life sentence in a Shanghai prison.

Red Cross President Alfred M. Gruenther said he had received word from the Red Cross Society of the Chinese Peoples Democratic Republic granting Mrs. Redmond's request to make another visit. She last saw her son in his China prison in 1958.

Mr. Redmond has been held on unspecified Communist charges of espionage since the Korean War.

His mother made the journey to see him in 1958 along with the mothers of two other Americans also prisoners of the Chinese Communists.
