SUBJECT: William W. Broom, DULUTH NIMES TRIBUNG Reporter

- 1. According to Subject, who has just returned from Cuba with other U.S. newsmen, he was contacted by Senstor Humphrey prior to his departure. Senstor Humphrey asked him to make contacts to try to speed up the release of the Pasquale family, the family of the well-known baseball player.
- 2. Broom's Cuban escort was Fablo Ruiz, a former Olympic backetball player who went to a military prep school in the U.S., and was here as late as 1961 when he visited his insurance partner in Miami. Rulz is a close friend of Llamouse, who is reportedly the head of International Sports, and the man who will be taking the Cuban team to the Tokyo Clympics. Rulz is thought to have contacted Llancusa with Broom's request for acceleration of the Pasquale family case.
- 3. At any rate, within two hours after Broom's request, the Pesquale family had received a telegram saying that all six of them could leave the country at once. They did leave Cubs and came here via Mentico.
