## CIA accused of trying to kill Sukarno

JAKARTA, Sept. 6.—President Sukarno today accused the American Central Intelligence Agency of trying to destroy him, reports APA.

The President said, international imperialism was now on the offensive and was trying to destroy Indonesia and Sukarno.

"They have been trying to overthrow Sukarno, destroy his dignity and even try to kill Sukarno. I have the proof," the President declared in a speech.

"In some places now there are snipers to kill Sukarno."

Speaking to a popular organization called the 1945 genera-

tion, many of whom knew him during the fight for independence from the Dutch, President Sukarno insisted the C.I.A. was involved in a plot against him.

He said, he had received a letter from British philosopher Bertrand Russell stating that the C.I.A. had expanded its budget five times to intensify its activities.

"Russell told me I should be more vigilant because my country will suffer more difficulties," President Sukarno said.

He called on the 1945 generation not to be trapped by C.I.A. who would try to destroy Indonesia and its President.
