RUSSELL ACCUSATION AGAINST CIA

BUENOS AIRES REUTERS IN SPANISH 1440Z 14 AUG 66 E

(TEXT) KARACHI--BRITISH PHILOSOPHER LORD BERTRAND RUSSELL HAS ACCUSED THE U.S. CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE AGENCY OF TRYING TO ISOLATE AND ELIMINATE PRESIDENT AYUB KHAN.

IN AN ARTICLE PUBLISHED TODAY IN THE KARACHI MORNING NEWS, THE FAVOUR 84-YEAR-OLD PACIFIST STATED THAT IMPERIALISM'S SILENT ARMY WANTED TO DESTROY PAKISTAN BECAUSE IT WAS FOLLOWING AN INDEPENDENT POLICY. HE ACCUSED THE CIA OF HAVING INSTIGATED THE ARMED ATTACK AGAINST PAKISTAN LAST SEPTEMBER. HE WAS REFERRING TO THE WAR BETWEEN PAKISTAN AND INDIA.

LORD RUSSELL ALSO ACCUSED THE WESTERN PRESS OF HAVING SPREAD RUMORS INTENDED TO DIVIDE AND INTIMIDATE THE PAKISTANI LEADERS. HE ADDED THAT KASHMIR IS AN EVIDENT CASE OF SELF-DETERMINATION VIOLATED BY A FOREIGN POWER, THAT IS, INDIA.
