Top Communists Spy for U.S., Sen. Young Says

Some Communist party officials are valuable spies for this country, Sen. Milton R. Young, R-N.D., says.

The Senator, who serves on a Senate Appropriations subcommittee handling funds for the Central Intelligence Agency, put it this way:

"Many of our most valuable CIA operatives in various countries throughout the world are actually high-ranking Communist party officials."
