RED WRITER QUATOS SENATOR YOUNG

Que, the unofficial organ of the Venezuelan Communist Party, which is published weekly in Caracas, made the following observation about the CIA in its 21 Oct 66 issue:

"Senator Young denounced the CIA for contracting Vietnamese murderers to comit atrocities in the villages 'in the name of the Viet-Cong.'"

The statement was contained in a weekly editorial column written by "Arturo Pym." It was made in connection with other examples gleaned by the columnist of opposition of prominent Americans to the war in Vietnam. The weekly regularly devotes a small percentage of its paper to this sort of anti-US propoganda. The CIA is not often mentioned in connection with US efforts in Vietnam.
