HEINE IS SUING A FELLOW ENIGNANT, JURI RAUS, NOW AN ENGINEER WITH THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS IN WASHINGTON, ON GROUNDS THAT RAUS TRIED TO DISCREDIT HIM WITH EMIGRANT GROUPS BY CALLING HIM A SOVIET MINTELLIGENCE AGENT.

THE CIA HAS CONFIRMED THAT RAUS WAS A CIA OPERATIVE. THE AGENCY SAIDERAUS WAS A SOURCE OF INFORMATION ON ESTONIA--NOW A PART OF THE SOVIET UNION--AND THAT HE PERFORMED "SPECIFIC ASSIGNMENTS" ALSO.

HAS CONTENDED THAT HE IS IMMUNE FROM PROSECUTION ON GROUNDS HE WAS FOLLOWING CIA ORDERS.
