U-2 Aircraft on Loan to SAC

l. As per your memorandum of 23 July, I discussed this subject with General Carter at the 9 o'clock meeting on 24 July, Mr. McCone not being present. General Carter remembered the requirement of the Secretary of Defense to do a study on a standard U. S. U-2 configuration and wanted to know how this study fitted in with our proposal to recall the J-75 U-2's from SAC. I informed him that Steakley felt personally that things were quiet enough to warrant this. The General did not make a decision but wants this converted to a staff paper for him, which includes staff coordination with DOD. The degree of this coordination was not specified. Please accomplish. I-think they are agreeable, however, to returning all our birds to if we can get our "ducks" in line.

2. Pending completion of this study, we will have to return the third U-2 to SAC and I have informed Col. Steakley that we will do so.
