- 1. During the USIB Meeting of 16 September 1965 (reference e.), it was agreed that it would be best to defer completion of USIB action on the report by the Ad Hoc Committee on Overseas Processing and Reporting chaired by the National Reconnaissance Office (NRO) (reference a.) pending completion of a major study of photo-interpretation facilities which had been requested by the Bureau of the Budget.
- 2. The results of this study were contained in the report of the Joint Imagery Interpretation Review Group (JIRG). The Director of Central Intelligence in reference f. informed the Board of the approval by him and the Deputy Secretary of Defense of the recommendations by the JIRG. As indicated therein, the USIB was identified as the authority responsible for monitoring and coordinating the implementation and execution of the National Tasking Plan. The National Tasking Plan provides that tasking of 25X1 will be in consonance with USIB decisions, and that first-phase exploitation




