THE DEFINITION OF A "SPECIAL ACCESS PROGRAM" IS CONTAINED IN THE DOD ISPR PARAGRAPH 12-101 WITH SPECIAL EMPHASIS ON THE LAST PORTION OF THE DEFINITION WHICH BASES ACCESS ON A FORMAL LIST OF PERSONS DETERMINED TO HAVE A NEED TO KNOW.
