[redacted] - JGO) Received a request from Mike Finley, Inter-American Affairs Subcommittee staff, House Foreign Affairs Committee for a background briefing for Chairman Dante Fascell and Representative Robert Steele (R., Conn.) on the coup in Chile. Chairman Fascell plans open hearings with the State Department as soon as possible and would appreciate a backgrounder as soon as conditions have stabilized sufficiently. Chairman Fascell had suggested possibly Monday or Tuesday afternoon, 17 or 18 September if appropriate. [redacted] DDI, has been advised.

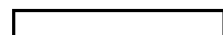
