LIBERATOR (WOLFOHTH) CASE

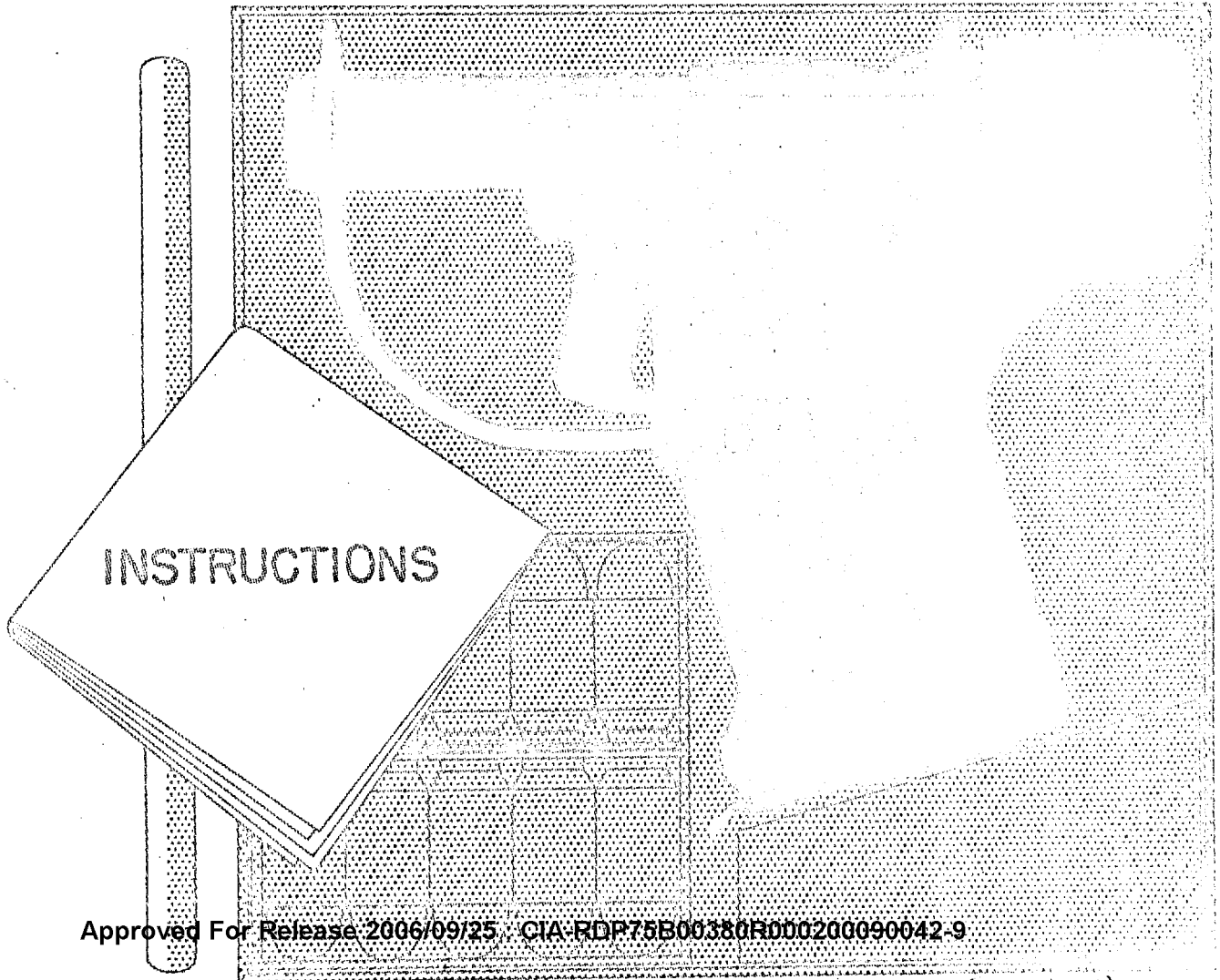

DESCRIPTION: The Liberator is a single-shot .45 caliber hand weapon. The operator loads the pistol with a single round by the procedure shown in the accompanying diagram. After the cartridge has been fired it is necessary to push the cartridge case out of the breech by a small stick furnished with the pistol. 10 rounds of standard .45 caliber ball ammunition, which can be carried in the handle of the piece, and a sheet of pictorial instructions are enclosed with the gun in a waterproof carton.

PURPOSE: The use of this gun is primarily for distribution in large numbers among patriots. The construction is very simple and inexpensive. The accompanying instruction sheet is in pictorial form and needs no explanatory text or

personal instruction, thus the language and literacy problem is solved. The low accuracy of the pistol and useful range of approximately 25 yards limit it to close-proximity anti-personnel work. Besides its physical use, this weapon, if discovered by the enemy, carries the psychological factor of inducing fear in enemy troops in occupied countries.
