(Confidential - GLC) Picked up from the Senate Armed Services Committee two copies of the transcript of the Director's appearance before the Committee on the proposal to increase the CIARDS retirement quota. We are to sanitize this transcript for publication and return it to the Committee. I also obtained copies of the bill as reported by the Committee and the Committee Report.

5. (Unclassified - JGO) Received a call from Lynn Burns, Caseworker in the office of Representative Robert Kastenmeier (D., Wis.), who requested application forms for Agency employment for a constituent.

6. (Unclassified - JGO) Received a call from Bruce Merkle, Administrative Assistant to Representative William Bray (R., Ind.), who asked if we would see what had happened to Bray's subscription to FBIS reports. For some reason none have been received in the last several weeks. [REDACTED] FBIS, has been advised.

(Internal Use Only - PLC) Picked up for NARCOG a transcript of the testimony on 4 April 1973 by the Attorney General, Office of Management and Budget, and Commissioner of Customs before the Subcommittee on Legislative and Military Operations of the House Committee on Government Operations. The hearing concerned the President's reorganization plan number 2 of 1973 to consolidate drug law enforcement activities.
