25X1 8. [redacted] Jane McMullan, Senate Appropriations Committee staff, called and asked if we could be of assistance to their office in handling a technical problem involving one of their three-way combination safes. I have been in touch with the Office of Security and we will take care of this some time next week.

25X1 9. [redacted] Received a call from J. Sourwine, Chief Counsel, Senate Internal Security Subcommittee, who has been talking with 25X1 Al Tarabochia, of the staff, about their access to [redacted] 25X1 Sourwine said he felt that an arrangement whereby they would submit their questions to [redacted] through us was not very satisfactory. He is quite insistent 25X1 on Tarabochia's seeing [redacted] (assuming that [redacted] has no objection to this himself). After conferring with [redacted] WH Division, I told Sourwine 25X1 we would get in touch with [redacted] and raise the question with him and if it was agreeable we would make arrangements for direct contact between 25X1 Tarabochia and him. In discussing their interest in seeing [redacted] further, Sourwine explained that they were interested in talking with him about someone 25X1 whom he knew in the [redacted] when he was there. I gathered from Sourwine's comments that they feel this individual is now engaged in questionable activities in Germany.

25X1 10. [redacted] Met with David Martin, Senate Internal Security Subcommittee staff, and provided him with some additional material 25X1 on meetings which [redacted] has had with foreigners over the years. 25X1 Martin is making a compilation of all of [redacted] activities which he plans to publish in a Committee document. Martin raised some questions about this material which I was unable to answer and I told him I would try to have someone who had prepared this material talk with him directly.

25X1 11. [redacted] Angus Thuermer contacted us about a call he received from the office of Representative Richard W. Mallary (R., Vt.) asking if someone from the Agency could speak to a group of 30 high school seniors from Mount Anthony High School, Bennington, Vermont, on 24 or 25 25X1 October. After checking with [redacted] Office of Training, I told Becky, in Mallary's office, that we could do this and she will come back to us with a suggested date and time.
