11. (Unclassified - LLM) Spoke with David Martin, Senate Internal Security Subcommittee staff, who said that the proposed Subcommittee print concerning [redacted] is in galleys and perhaps will be in final form in the next several weeks. STAT

Martin made reference to a JPRS translation that he had received two months ago, "Political Parties of Africa," which he characterized as an April 1971 Communist master plan of the conquest of Africa. Martin said the Subcommittee is thinking of issuing a print on the subject, matching developments over the past two years against the plan, and asked if we could provide (1) copies of articles covering Communist operations in Africa during the past few years and (2) such other substantive comments as we may be able to provide.
